Mission:

To foster and assist entrepreneur development in Lowndes County, and to create the most pro-business environment in Georgia for new and existing businesses.

2018 Goals:

Client Service

- Provide service to 500 clients (497 clients served in 2017)
- Assist 15 entrepreneurs successfully start a new business (14 assisted in 2017)
- Host or co-host 25 Business University events with an average of 20 at each (Co-hosted 29 events with an average of 18 at each in 2017)
- Business University events with an average attendance of 18 attendees in 2017)
- Continue to improve SEEDS Website market to attract 250 monthly visitors (202 average monthly visitors in 2017)

Young Entrepreneurship

- Oversee Directors of the second year of YEA! with 20 students for the 2018-19 school year
- (Kick off August 30) (13 students participated in the inaugural year of YEA! Valdosta
- 2017-18 School Year)
- Coordinate the first Astor's Children Business Fair with 30 participating children (May 19)

Southwest Georgia Bank Business Plan Competition

- Recruit 16 qualified contestants and retain 10 qualified finalists (16 qualified contestants and 13 semi-finalists in 2017)
- Secure 20 Angel Prize Pack Sponsors and hold four Lunch & Learns for contestants to meet Angels (4 Lunch & Learns in 2017)

Incubator Development

- Obtain EDA and other grant funding for the incubator (early 2018)

- Ribbon cutting for small business incubator (by December)

Mission:

To promote business and community development by encouraging area companies to become and to remain certified drug free workplaces, thereby increasing productivity and safety in the workplace and reducing the companies' Workers Compensation insurance premiums by 7.5%.

- Communicate regularly with Chamber partners (i.e., 10 chambers of commerce in South Georgia) to enhance current relationships

- Retain 210 drug-free workplaces throughout the 12-county network (210 in 2017)
- Recruit 15 new members within the 12-county network for a goal of 225 members
